Additional information relating to cash resources

4. A renounceable rights issue was completed in May 2008 raising a net \$528,000. The purpose of the issue is to provide additional working capital. The issue was not underwritten.
5. The sale of the 70% interest in the Cassegrain Wines business was completed on 26 June 2008. The proceeds were applied to debt reduction.
6. Discussions are still continuing with various parties in relation to the sale of the Mudgee processing facilities and the remaining vineyards.

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
