Prince Hill Wines was named after James Prince, an early pioneer who owned the land and lived in the homestead which is now the site of the vineyard and winery located in the town of Mudgee NSW. A burial site next to the winery remains in testament to him. Born in 1862 James Prince travelled to North America as a young man in search of gold. A few years later he returned to his home in Mudgee to work the land. The company has a number of brands that pay homage to the hard years endured by the early Mudgee pioneers who reared sheep and cattle, fossicked for gold and established the first crops, including grapes, in the region.

Prince Hill Wines specialises in the production of wines for Mediterranean grape varieties which are sourced for our own and our grower's premium vineyards on the western slopes of the Great Dividing Range. The warm climate and rich alluvial soils of the region produce fine Chardonnay, Sangiovese and Shiraz.
